SUBJECT: USAGE OF "NO-LEAD" OR "LOW-LEAD" GASOLINE

Many questions have been raisen concerning the usage of new gasolines (i.e. "No-Lead" - phosphorous type and "low-lead" content) for fuel in snow-mobile engines.

Please take note and advise your customers that MOTO-SKI LIMITED DOES NOT RECOMMEND THE USAGE OF THESE TYPE OF GASOLINE FOR SNOWMOBILE FUEL.

Damage to piston and risk of engine seizure may result by using such type of fuel, since the octane rating is lower, detonation and pre-ignition may occur inside the combustion chamber.
